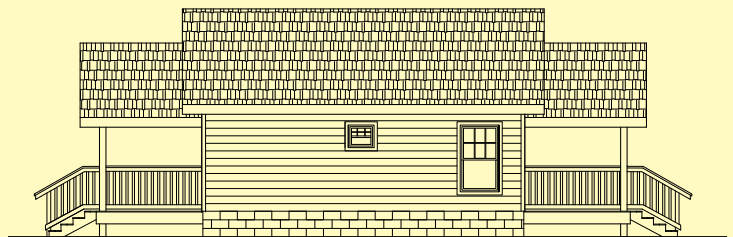
Friends of Camp

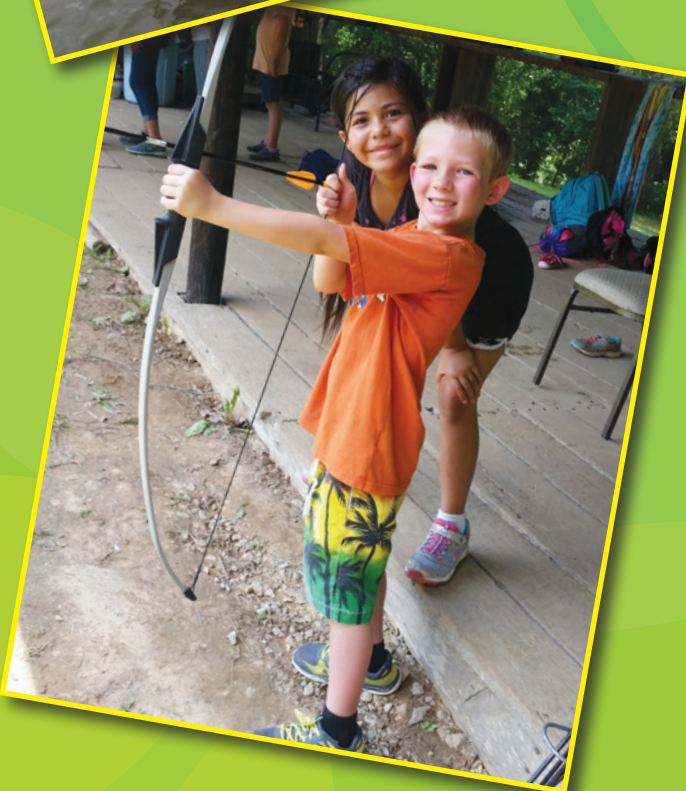
