Coming Soon: Flex Housing

For the first time in our history, we turned away campers this summer. Two of our weeks were at or beyond capacity. This is unacceptable. Your camp board has taken steps to develop more housing. Our current plan is to build eight "tiny house"-style cabins that can be used for multiple purposes. These units will provide overflow housing for campers, while also serving as options for volunteer workers, adult leaders, couples, and families.

We anticipate the cost of materials to be about \$25,000 per cabin, and hope to use volunteer labor for construction. Thanks to some generous donors and a grant from the FWB

Foundation, we currently have funds to build two of these units. Please pray with us that God will provide the funds and laborers we need to complete the other six.
